

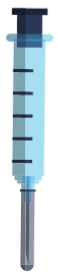
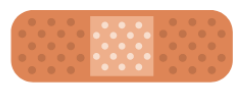

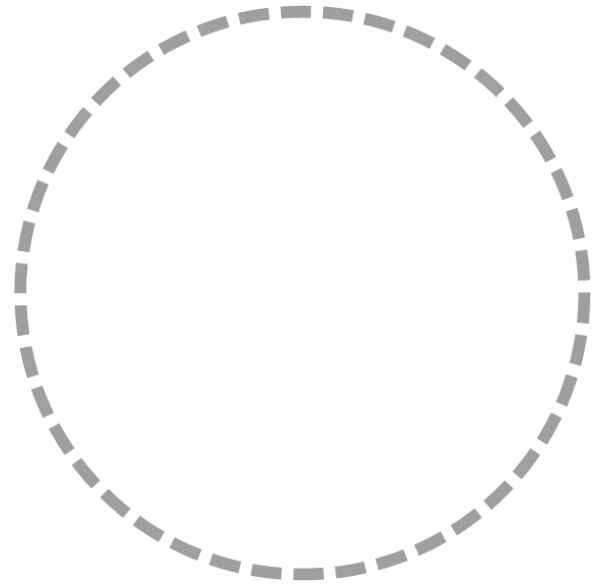

## Respiratory Syncytial Virus:
