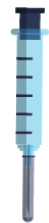
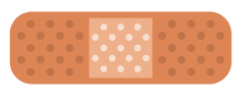

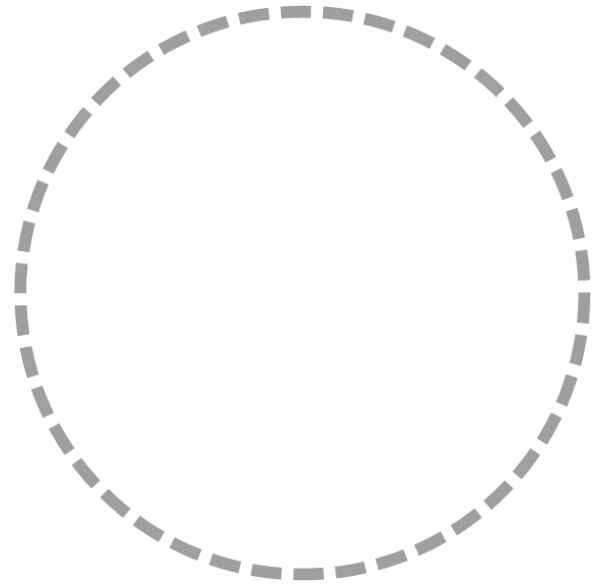

RSV is a common virus that is easy to spread during cold & flu season.

It can be dangerous for babies.

RSV clogs little lungs, making it hard to breathe.

Some babies - like those who were born early, have heart problems, or have chronic lung conditions are especially vulnerable.
